The Painted & Photographed Bean: A Coffee Art Perspective

Pacific Bay Coffee Co. & Micro-Roastery and Gaia Arts Center in Berkeley, CA will be showcasing local fine artists at The Specialty Coffee Association of America's Western Regional Barista Competition (WRBC) March 28-30, 2008, in Berkeley, CA. The event is open to the public and free.

A themed art show, entries should depict the art and love of coffee from seed to cup (growing, harvesting, roasting, brewing and making espresso) or touch upon the senses of enjoying coffee. Images depicting latte art poured by skilled baristas are encouraged.

BEST OF SHOW

Pacific Bay Coffee Co. & Micro-Roastery and Gaia Arts Center employees will vote on their favorite unmarked (artist name not visible) submission based on creativity and the depiction of the art and love of coffee. The winner will receive some of the best coffee products on the market—a Baratza Virtuoso Burr Grinder, Bodum's Ibis Kettle, Shin Bistro Press Pot & Mugs, and fresh roasted coffee from Pacific Bay Coffee Co. & Micro-Roastery (retail value \$300).

There is no fee to participate and artists can choose to offer their submission for sale without commissions by direct contact from the interested buyer and the artist. The entries will be on exhibit during the WRBC at the Gaia Arts Center and at Pacific Bay Coffee Co in Berkeley, CA. 50+ entries will be selected: 40 for display at the Gaia Arts Center and 10+ for display at Pacific Bay Coffee Co's Walnut Creek café or Berkeley roastery.

Entries must be:

- Two-dimensional works of art (paintings, photography, collage, drawings, screenprints).
- Maximum size 24"x36" and 10 pounds.
- Framed and/or finished and ready to hang with two screw eye hooks in place on the back of the artwork. We will add the hanging wire.
- · All ages welcome to participate.
- One entry per person.
- Submissions not meeting these guidelines will not be accepted.

The Western Regional Barista

Competition (WRBC) is an event designed to encourage and recognize professional achievement in the art of espresso beverage preparation and service. Competitors will prepare and service 12 coffee beverages - one espresso, one cappuccino, and one signature drink of their own creation, for four judges in a space of 15 minutes. The winner of the WRBC goes on to compete at the United States Barista Championship (USBC). The winner of the USBC will represent the United States at the World Barista Championship to be held in Copenhagen in June 2008.
